Minutes of PEC meeting held on November 13, 2010

The following items are the highlights of the meeting (approved motions ONLY have been reported):

1. We reviewed all activities to date and expanded our involvement with National PEC by providing input on mentoring and the industrial exemption.
2. Bill has agreed to welcome PEC members to attend his courses with the Transit Authority. He typically offers Construction Management, Quality Assurance and Quality Control, Inspection for Concrete Work and more. Rudi will coordinate this new offering using Survey Monkey system that has served us so well.
3. The series with the N.Y.C. Department of Buildings [DOB] has been very successful in Brooklyn, Queens and Manhattan. Since September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010, approximately 37 engineers signed up for fully paid membership as result of the PEC incentives for all new members to attend the seminars at no additional cost. Prior to that, approximately 55 engineers signed up for a 6 months free trial membership to NSPE, as result of the PEC incentives for all new members to attend the seminars at no additional cost.
